PRODUCT INTRODUCTION

Evasure Cream is a medicine used in the treatment of rosacea, which is an inflammatory condition that affects face. It helps in reducing the redness, swelling and pimples associated with rosacea.

Your doctor will explain how to use Evasure Cream and how much you need. Read the instructions that come with the medicine to make sure you use it correctly. It is applied to the affected areas of your face as directed by your doctor. Your skin should be clean, and dry before using it. Avoid getting it into your mouth, eyes, or inside the nose. Use it regularly and at the same time of each day to get the most benefit of the medicine.

Evasure Cream may cause burning, irritation, itching, and redness at the site of application. These are usually temporary and go away with time. However, if these effects persist or worsen, inform your doctor. Before using it, you should ask your doctor's advice if you are pregnant or breastfeeding.

BENEFITS OF IVREA CREAM

In Rosacea

Rosacea is a reddening of the skin that mainly affects the face. Evasure Cream helps to relieve the symptoms caused by rosacea, such as redness, swelling, and pimples. This medicine usually makes you feel better quite quickly. However, you should continue taking it as long as it is prescribed even when you feel better, to get maximum benefit. If you do not see significant improvement within a few days, talk to your doctor.

SIDE EFFECTS OF IVREA CREAM

Most side effects do not require any medical attention and disappear as your body adjusts to the medicine. Consult your doctor if they persist or if you're worried about them

Common side effects of Ivrea

- Application site reactions (burning, irritation, itching and redness)
- Dizziness
- Itching
- Peripheral edema
- Fever
- Joint pain
- Swelling of lymph nodes
- Synovitis

- Nausea
- Diarrhea
- Orthostatic hypotension (sudden lowering of blood pressure on standing)
- Facial swelling
- Fast heart rate
- Increased white blood cell count (eosinophils)
- Increased hemoglobin
- Increased alanine aminotransferase
- Increased aspartate aminotransferase
- Decreased white blood cell count

HOW TO USE **Evasure Cream**

This medicine is for external use only. Use it in the dose and duration as advised by your doctor. Check the label for directions before use. Clean and dry the affected area and apply the cream. Wash your hands after applying, unless hands are the affected area.

HOW **Evasure Cream**

WORKS

Evasure Cream is an antiparasitic medication to be applied on skin. It works by binding to the muscle and nerve cells of worms, causing their paralysis and death. This treats your infection.
